- Godless lifestyle:
 - Rejecting authority – 2 Pet. 2:10
 - Embracing immorality – 2 Pet. 2:13-14



○ Serving only themselves – Jude 12, 16

• Our response: *Contend for the faith* – Jude 3, 2 Pet. 3:17

• The folly of denying God’s judgment – 2 Pet. 3:8-9
